RULES FOR REGISTRATION FOR FULL-TIME FIRST-CYCLE STUDIES IN ENGLISH for students starting their studies in the 2025/2026 academic year

- 11. Registration after 1 semester of study:
- a) maximum achievable credits in 1 semester of study: 30 ECTS;
- b) conditions for registration for the 2nd semester of study: obtaining 16 ECTS in 1 semester of study.
- 2. Registration after the first year of study:
- a) maximum achievable credits after the first year of study: 60 ECTS;
- b) conditions for registration for the second year of study: obtaining 40 ECTS credits in the first year of study.
- 3. Registration after the second year of study:
- a) maximum achievable credits after the second year of study: 120 ECTS;
- b) conditions for registration for the third year of study: obtaining at least 100 ECTS: 60 ECTS from the first year of study and a minimum of 40 ECTS from the second year of study.
- 4. Registration after the third year of study:
- a) maximum achievable credits after the third year of study: 180 ECTS;
- b) conditions for registration for the fourth year of study: obtaining at least 150 ECTS: 60 ECTS from the first year, 60 ECTS from the second year of study and a minimum of 30 ECTS from the third year of study.

Completion of studies- 195 ECTS, including 4 ECTS for internships.

- Recommendations and restrictions on enrollment in courses in subsequent semesters are included in the course regulations.
- Students are required to check that they are correctly enrolled in courses offered in a given semester, based, among other things, on the course regulations concerning the completion of specified prerequisites.
- If a course is not completed, the student must first repeat the course.
- In accordance with the Study Regulations, students may be registered for no more than two semesters beyond the nominal duration of their studies.
- If students fail to obtain a final grade within the prescribed time limit, they must apply to repeat the semester.
- If a student has obtained a final grade, it is possible to postpone the deadline for submitting the thesis by no more than three months.

Qualification for the list of diploma paths takes place during the sixth semester based on a ranking list created based on the declaration of preference for the choice of diploma path and the weighted average of grades for five semesters. Groups in diploma paths are made by the dean's decision, depending on the number of applicants and organisational possibilities.



RULES FOR REGISTRATION FOR FULL-TIME SECOND-CYCLE STUDIES IN ENGLISH for students starting their studies in the academic year 2025/2026

- 1. Registration after 1 semester of study:
- a) maximum achievable credits in 1 semester of study: 30 ECTS;
- b) condition for registration for the 2nd semester of study: obtaining 8 ECTS in 1 semester of study.
- 2. Registration after the 1st year of study:
- a) maximum achievable credits after the first year of study: 60 ECTS;
- b) condition for registration for the second year of study: obtaining 40 ECTS credits in the first year of study.

Completion of studies - 100 ECTS.

- Recommendations and restrictions on enrollment in courses in subsequent semesters are included in the course regulations.
- Students are required to check that they are correctly enrolled in courses offered in a given semester, based, among other things, on the course regulations concerning the completion of specified prerequisites.
- If a course is not completed, the student must first repeat the course.
- In accordance with the Study Regulations, students may be registered for no more than two semesters beyond the nominal duration of their studies.
- If a student fails to obtain a final grade within the prescribed time limit, they must apply to repeat the semester.
- If a student has obtained a final grade, it is possible to postpone the deadline for submitting the thesis by no more than three months.

Qualification for the list of diploma paths takes place during the first semester based on a list of preferences for the choice of specialisation. Depending on the number of applicants and organisational possibilities, groups in the diploma paths are created by the dean's decision.
